Yankee Doodle is the Connecticut state song.

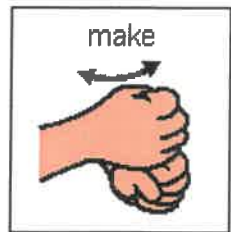
The Statue of Liberty that is in New York City was a gift from the people of France to the United States in 1884.
