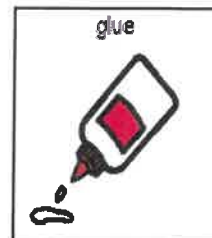
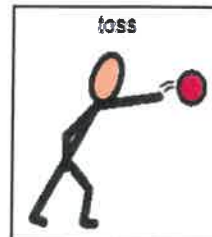
Orville and Wilbur Wright tossed a coin to see who was going to make the first self-powered flight in history that took place in North Carolina.

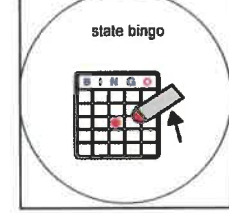
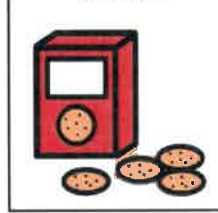
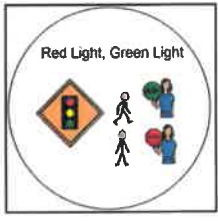
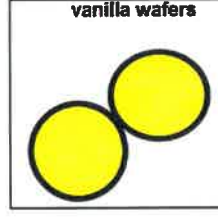
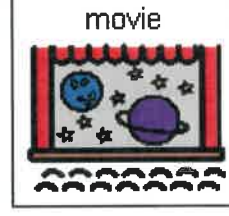
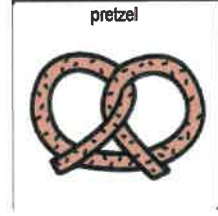
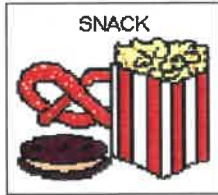
Actions we did:
