Park has:

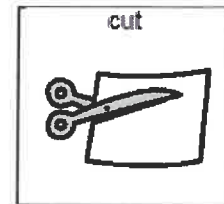
60 types of mammals

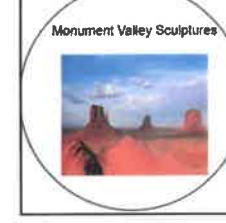
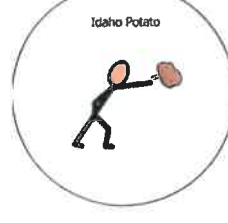
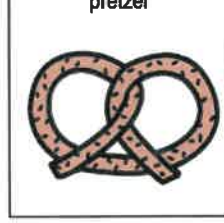
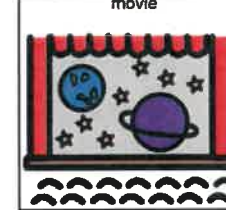
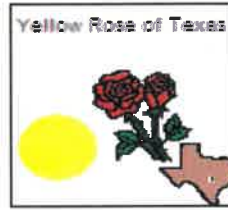
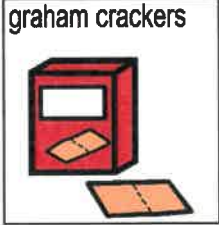
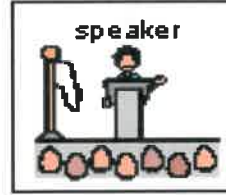
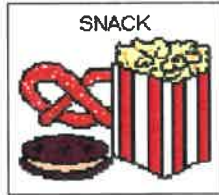
Actions we did:
