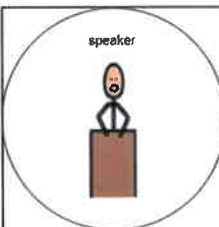
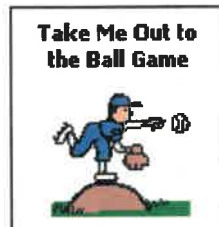
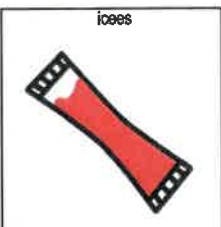
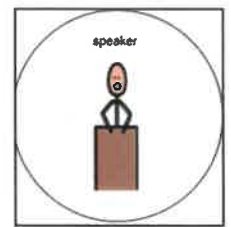
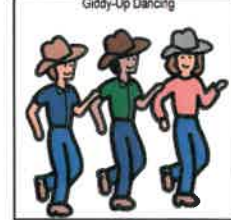
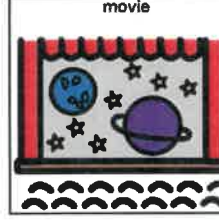
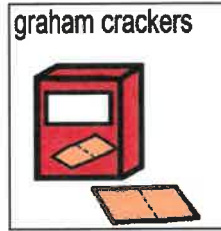
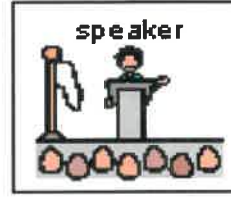
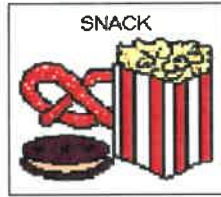
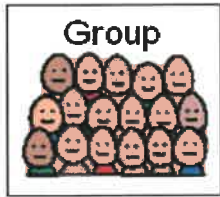
Actions we did:
